### History of ETS verifier's accreditation



- ✓ Phase I and phase II of EU ETS
  - ✓ Non harmonized accreditation in EU
  - ✓ Germany used individual accreditation as "sworn expert" by Chambers of Industry and Commerce or as EMAS verifier
  - ✓ Examination of individuals by a panel
    → fair process regarding competence evaluation
  - ✓ But no further regular surveillance

### Experiences in Germany and the EU



#### Performance of verifiers

- Decreasing amount of findings in accreditation
- Same for findings by the Cas
- Specific difficulties when introducing the concept of independent review
- Competence process is in focus of accreditation audits

#### Running the accreditation process

- ✓ Largely harmonized over EU since phase 3
- ✓ Partly inclusion of CA personnel as assessors
- ✓ Feedback loops by all involved parties (e.g. an annual workshop) show benefits and increase common understanding




#### ✓ The well know hen and egg story

- ✓ Who is assessing the competence in a to-be-established MRVA system?
- How to recruit competent accreditation assessors when no expert are available on the market

#### ✓ Problems were faced by

- ✓ CDM/JI accreditation panel
- ✓ EU member countries at start of ETS
- Accreditation bodies when implementing the EU AVR
- Almost every economy introducing a new certification/verification scheme



#### Experiences from capacity building activities



#### ✓ Some approaches

- ✓ Initial competence assessment by the authority (Turkey)
- Examinations of initial multipliers (Ukraine)
- Examination panel covering all (most) sectors
- ✓ Risk based approach in surveillance → higher frequency of witness activities when establishing a new scheme or for new entrants
- Embedding national accreditation bodies in international capacity building activities
- ✓ Clear communication of Third Party concept (stakeholder involvement)
